Uploading images for Close-Up

If you have a competition image that is selected for publication in *Close-U*p, or images to be included in an article, would you please send it to the editor using the following process.

Please send me a full size PSD or TIF file (preferably) not the 1400 x 1050 jpg submitted for the comp. This enables me to get the highest possible image quality within the constraints of *Close-Up* printing.

If you are sending multiple files, it is easiest if you create a zip file (use zipx if possible) with them all in it and upload that instead of individual images.

The image should be unsharpened (or with the sharpening on a separate layer) with preferably all layers intact (ie not flattened).

For competition images, please include the name from the list in the email requesting the file as the first part of your uploaded filename.

Please ensure that there is no "watermark" (i.e. your name/title) in your image.

Please use DropBox or another file transfer service that allows me to retrieve the file without signing up for a service or "accepting" their conditions. [Do **NOT** use We Transfer, I can't retrieve images from their service].

With DropBox you need to "send" me the file, not give me access to a folder on your computer, see the accompanying file "Dropbox to Close-Up.pdf". Note: the link that you paste into your e-mail to me must end with ?dl=0.
