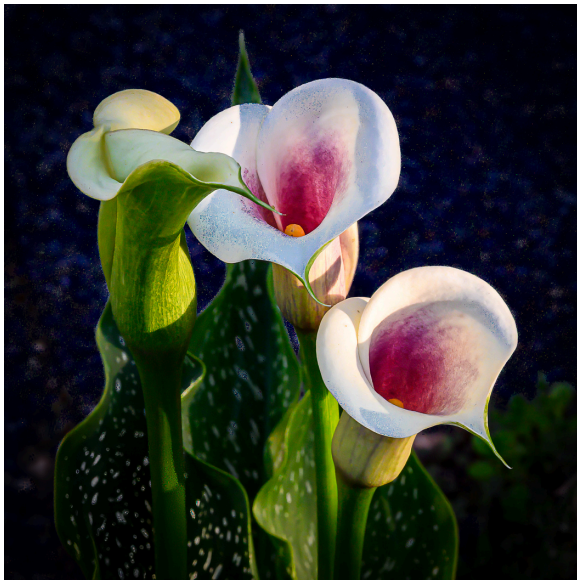


Frank Turner Award 2025-2026

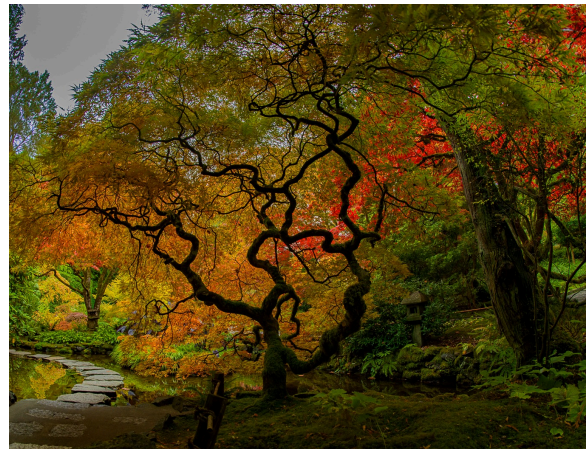
